



Hello Yukon Physicians,

We want to thank you for your cooperation and patience as we rolled out the new <u>online</u> <u>licensing system</u> (LOL) during the renewal period. We are now fully digital, and highlights include:

- Access your licence and receipts anytime
- Apply for certificates of standing online
- Online payments for all services
- Easily add endorsements, additional competencies, or strike your licence

Please take some time to explore <u>your account</u> as well as view your information on the <u>public</u> <u>register</u> – you can edit your own your information at any time.

In addition to the LOL system, we also rolled out the <u>CFTA licensure route</u>, (Canadian Free Trade Agreement) eliminating the physicansapply requirement for those who are already fully licensed in another Canadian jurisdiction.

<u>The locum licence</u> (1 three-month period) has been available for a year now and is being used regularly. If you know someone who is interested in exploring work in the Yukon but doesn't want to commit to full licensure yet – this is an excellent opportunity.

MAiD Standard of Practice

The YMC has been working hard to make necessary updates to the Standards of Practice for Medical Assitance in Dying. The modernized standard will be posted to the website in the coming days and you will receive a notification to your email when it is available.

RECORDS

YMC wishes to remind all physicians that they are responsible for ensuring patients have access to their personal records in a timely manner. For more information please see the records standard on the YMC webpage.
